Q: How do I vote for my favourite artwork?

A: To vote for your favourite artwork, go to https://ukts.org/contest-entries/, select the artwork you want to vote for, and click on the "star" button.

Remember you can vote once in each of the 5 age categories (3-5, 6-9, 10-12, 13-16 and 17+)

Q. how will I know if my vote was registered?

A. Once you have selected your favourite piece and clicked on the star, you should see a pop up message thanking you for your vote, in addition to a green tick.

Q: Do I need to be a UKTS member to vote?

Q. What are trustee prizes?
